

1. [Publication policy] Organ Biology, the official journal of the Japan Society for Organ Preservation and Biology (JSOPB) is a peer-reviewed online journal published on J-STAGE. It covers research on preserving and improving organ, tissue, and cell function. The format categories are original papers, reviews, and others (Commentary, Voice from Members, Meeting Report, Book Review, etc.).
  2. [Provision] Manuscripts must not be published or must not be submitted to another journal. The criteria for duplicate submissions follow the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors' Recommendation, III.D. Overlapping Publications.
  3. [Author attribute] The first and responsible authors of the submitted manuscript must be members of JSOPB. This does not apply to the manuscripts the Editorial Board has asked for contribution.
  4. [Research compliance] Ensure that the research methods comply with the legal and ethical standards in force at the time of the research and state this clearly in the manuscript. The legal and ethical standards include ethical guidelines for research with human subjects and human materials, embryo manipulation, animal experiments, gene modification, and radioisotope experiments.
  5. [Conflict of interest] Disclose conflicts of interest and, if necessary, submit a conflict-of-interest self-assessment form.
  6. [Submission] Manuscripts (text, tables, and figures) must be in Japanese or English and sent by e-mail to the Editorial Board (address below) The manuscript must follow the 'Writing and Submission Instructions' below.
  7. [Copyright] The copyright of the articles published in Organ Biology belongs to JSOPB. Copyright status is Creative Commons CC BY-NC-SA 4.0 (Non-Commercial-Share Alike 4.0). Reproduction for commercial purposes must follow the 'Regulations for Reproduction of Papers and Articles Published in Organ Biology'(see below).
  8. [Decision for publication] The Editorial Board decides the acceptance or rejection of manuscripts. The Editorial Board may request revisions, deletions, or additions to the manuscript.
  9. [Publication] The accepted manuscripts of the same categories are published in the order of the date of acceptance.

2. On the first page of the manuscript, please write the title, authors' names, affiliations, and contact e-mail address of the correspondence.
  3. For original articles, reviews, and commentaries, please accompany a 100-word abstract and keywords (up to 5 words) in English.
  4. For original articles, please write in the following order: abstract, introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, and references. For reviews and other articles, please follow the style of previously published articles.
  5. Please submit clear figures and photographs.
  6. When you wish to reproduce figures, photographs, or tables that have already been published, please follow the instructions of the publisher that holds the copyright.
  7. Please indicate the references in the text by the numbers in square brackets in the citing order. Please provide the list of bibliographic information in the ICMEJE format at the end of the text (ICMEJE format is the format used by PubMed).
