Submission of a manuscript implies: (1) that the work described has not been published before (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture, review, or thesis); (2) that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere; and (3) that its publication has been approved by all the authors as well as by the responsible authorities at the institute where the work has been carried out.

Copyright: when any paper is accepted for publication, the authors agree to automatic transfer of the copyright to the Society for Tsurumi University School of Dental Medicine, and that the manuscript will not be published elsewhere in any language without the consent of the copy right holder.

Instructions for authors

Papers will be accepted from members of the Society for Tsurumi University School of Dental Medicine only. Papers must be written in Japanese or English and should be submitted in triplicate to Editorial Committee of the Society for Tsurumi University School of Dental Medicine, Tsurumi 2–1–3, Tsurumi-ku, Yokohama 230–8501, Japan.

The final decision on acceptance of manuscript will be made by Editorial Committee on the basis of a peer reviewer system.

Use of animals. Manuscripts submitted for publication must contain a statement to the effect that all human studies have been reviewed by the appropriate ethics committee. Reports of animal experiments must state that the handling of animals has conformed to the guidelines for laboratory animal care.

Please consult the Technical instructions for manuscripts and illustrations published regularly in this journal. Manuscripts should be divided into the following sections: title page: Abstract; Introduction; Materials and methods; Results; Discussion; Acknowledgements; reference lists; figure legends and tables. The original manuscript must be typed double spaced with wide margins and on one side of the paper only. Genus and species names should be marked with a single straight underline for italics. The approximate desired positions of figures and tables should be marked in the margin of

the manuscript.

Brief accounts of particularly interesting results will be printed out of turn as Short communications.

Reviews are mostly written by invitation. Uninvited articles, however, are also considered for publication. In this case, the author(s) should contact the Editor-in Chief before preparing the manuscript.

Miscellaneous items including technical reports, clinical reports, book reviews, and commentaries may also be published on approval of the Editorial Committee.

- The title page must give: full title (as short as possible), authors, affiliations of authors, corresponding author with full address including telephone and fax numbers and an e-mail address.
- Abstract. Each paper should be preceded by a summary not exceeding 500 words in English and should be additionally accompanied by a summary not exceeding 1,200 words in Japanese.
- 3. References should be numbered sequentially as they appear in the text, followed by those in tables and finally those in the figure legends. Reference numbers apply only to papers published or in the press, and a different number should be given to each paper cited. All other forms of reference should be included in the text as personal communication, manuscript in preparation or preprint (with number and institution where appropriate). Abbreviated name of journal should be that given in *Index Medicus*. Reference to books should clearly indicate the publisher and the date and place of publication. References should be listed at the end of the text as follows:

- 4. Figures. The illustrations must be submitted in triplicate. Figures should be restricted in number to the minimum needed to clarify the text. Information given in the legends must not be repeated in text, nor should the same data be presented in both graph and table form. Illustrations that have already been published elsewhere are not usually accepted. All figures must be numbered consecutively and submitted on separate sheets. Each separate figure or each plate should be marked on the reverse side with the figure number, author's name, and brief title. Magnifications should be indicated by bar scales. Halftone illustrations should be submitted as sharp, glossy originals, maximally trimmed at right angles to eliminate areas without significant information content and be of the desired final size. Line drawings. Please submit good-quality prints. Inscriptions must be about 2 mm high and clearly visible. Figures should not exceed the page print area of 17.5 cm × 22.0 cm. They should match the width of the column (8.3 cm), the width of the entire page (17.5 cm) or be 12.5 cm wide. The publisher reserves the right to reduce or enlarge illustrations.
- Legends must be concise, following the style of the journal, and should provide a brief, self-sufficient explanation of the illustrations.
- 6. Tables. All tables must be numbered consecutively in arabic numerals. Each table must be typed on a separate sheet. The title of each table should provide a brief, self-sufficient explanation of its content.
- 7. **Proofs.** Changes made in proof should be limited to the correction of typographical errors.
- Manuscript in electronic form. Submission of electronic data is encouraged. Please transmit electronic data to Editorial Committee when your manuscript has been submitted.
- 9. Offprints can be ordered at cost price when proofs are returned to the publisher.
