12. 図・表の説明
図・表に分けて順に記載する。図1あるいはFig. 1，表1あるいはTab. 1 というようにすること。
13. 図・表の形式
- 1) 図・表の数は適切な範囲内とする。
 - 2) A4 の用紙を用いること。
 - 3) 罫表，図，写真はすべて本文末にまとめて，1つずつ用紙に印刷すること。
 - 4) 欧文の罫表でそのまま印刷を希望されるものは17.5 cm × 22 cm を越えないこと。
 - 5) 写真は，完成した原寸大の組写真（矢印，記号，符号など挿入ずみ）の形で投稿すること。
 - 6) 図，写真の寸法は17.5 cm × 22 cm を越えないこと。
14. その他
- 1) 数字はアラビア数字，外国語はすべて原綴とし，やむを得ない時だけ片仮名とする。
 - 2) 度量衡の単位，記号はS. I. 単位を原則とする。
例：kg, g, mg, kl, dl, ml, km, m, cm, mm, μm , nm, km^2 , m^2 , cm^2 , mm^2 など。
15. 原稿の掲載は原則として受理順とし，原稿の採否は編集委員会が決定する。
16. 提出する原稿はそれぞれ正1部および副2部とする。原稿を収納したCD-Rをプリントした原稿とともに提出する。Windows または Mac のテキストファイルであることが望ましい。CD-R のラベルには，論文名，著者名を記載する。
17. 上記の規定に沿わない原稿は受付けない場合がある。
18. 本誌掲載の著作物の編集著作権は本学会に帰属するものとする。ただし，論文の内容については著者が全責任を負う。
19. この規定にない事項は別に編集委員会で決定する。また規定の改正は編集委員会で行うことができる。

Submission Policy

1. This is the official journal of the Tsurumi University Dental Society. The journal is published twice a year.
2. The journal features reviews, assignment reports (or project studies), original works, case reports, technical papers, brief reports, literature reviews, conference reports, and other contributions.
3. Reviews and assignment reports are submitted at the request of the Editorial Board.
4. The journal accepts original works, case reports, technical papers, brief reports and literature reviews which are appropriate for the purpose of this journal and have not been published elsewhere.
5. The first authors and authors requesting reprints must be members of the Tsurumi Dental Society. However, co-authors from outside the Tsurumi University who are not graduates of the Tsurumi University are not required to be members.
6. For research involving human subjects and human materials (including epidemiological studies and case reports),

the paper must clearly state that the research complies with the Ethical Guidelines for Life Science and Medical Research Involving Human Subjects established by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare, and the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry.

7. For research involving animal experiments, the paper must clearly state that the research was conducted in accordance with the animal experimentation guidelines of the institution to which the researcher belongs and was approved by an ethics committee, etc.
8. For research where obtaining informed consent from subjects or patients is important, the paper must clearly state this.
9. Declare all conflicts of interest related to the content of the paper.
10. The classification, names, and content of the manuscripts are as follows:
 - 1) Original work: an original research paper.
 - 2) Case report: a report of an unusual case that may be of interest to society members.
 - 3) Technical papers: introduction of clinical techniques, research methods, or the use of pharmaceutical materials.
 - 4) Brief report: a concise presentation of interesting findings from an incomplete study.
 - 5) Literature review: a summary of the contents of particularly important paper among previously published papers.
11. Manuscripts of reviews, assignment reports (or project studies), original works, case reports, technical papers, and brief reports should be submitted in the following format.
 - 1) Manuscript format: Japanese or English. This manuscript should be submitted on recording media such as CD-R or DVD and printed on A4 size paper.

Pages should be numbered sequentially at the bottom of each sheet, starting with the cover as the first page.

The manuscript should be organized as follows: cover page, English abstract, main text, references, and descriptions of figures and tables, each section on a separate page.

Each page of the main text should contain around 1,200 characters.

Use the academic terms defined in the Japan Dental Terminology Compiled by Japanese Association for Dental Science.

Papers in English should include a Japanese title and abstract.
 - 2) The cover page should contain, in this order: manuscript classification, title, author names, affiliations, name of the leader (head), key words (up to 5 words in both English and Japanese), running title (up to 25 characters), and contact information (name, telephone number, e-mail address).
 - 3) The main text should contain, in this order: abstract, introduction, materials (subject) and methods, results and discussion.

Keep the main text concise and avoid repetition and subjective statements that are not based on research results.
 - 4) English Abstract: the purpose of the abstract is to enable readers who are not Japanese speakers to understand the contents of the paper.

Provide the title, author names, affiliations, name of the leader (head), and abstract in English.

The English abstract should be within 500 words. Generally, the abstract should include the purpose of the research, the used materials (subjects) and methods, obtained results and conclusions.
 - 5) References should only include what is essential to understand the paper. Do not include unpublished papers, but papers that have already been accepted for publication (or in press) may be cited as references if this is clearly indicated. References should be numbered in the text in the order they are cited, and the names of the references should be listed in the references section. (e.g., Araya 23)
- (1) For journal articles: Author (s) : Title, Journal Name, Volume : Pages, Year in this order.

It is preferable to abbreviate journal names following guidelines in Index Medicus.

- (3) For monographs with multiple authors: Author (s): Title, Names of Editors (Chief Editor), Monograph Title, Publisher, Place of Publication, Pages Cited, Year in this order.

12. Description of figures and tables

Use figures and tables separately to present the information in order. Name them Figure 1 or Fig. 1, Table 1 or Tab. 1, etc.

13. Format of figures and tables

1) Keep the number of figures and tables reasonable.

2) Use A4 size paper.

3) All tables, figures, and photographs should be collected together at the end of the text and printed individually on separate sheets of paper.

4) The dimensions of grid tables in European languages printed directly should not exceed 17.5 cm × 22 cm.

5) Submit photographs as complete, full-size composite images (with arrows, symbols, signs, etc. inserted).

6) The dimensions of figures and photographs should not exceed 17.5 cm × 22 cm.

14. Other

1) Use Arabic numerals for numbers and write foreign words in their original spelling. Only use katakana when unavoidable.

2) As a general rule, use SI units and symbols for weights and measures.

Examples: kg, g, mg, kl, dl, ml, km, m, cm, mm, μ m, nm, km², m², cm², mm², etc.

15. Manuscripts are generally published in the order they are received. The editorial board makes the final decision whether to accept or reject the manuscript.

16. Submit one original and two copies of each manuscript. Submit the CD-R containing the manuscript together with the printed copy of the manuscript. A Windows or Mac text file is preferred. Write the title of the paper and the name (s) of the author (s) on the CD-R label.

17. Manuscripts that do not comply with the above requirements may be rejected.

18. The editorial copyright for all works published in this journal belongs to the Society. However, the authors are fully responsible for the content of the papers.

19. Any matters not included in these regulations will be determined separately by the Editorial Board. The Editorial Board also reserves the right to amend these regulations.
