

Shimane Daigaku Igakubu Kiyo (Bulletin of Shimane University Faculty of Medicine)

1. Qualification for authors

Teaching staffs of Shimane University Faculty of Medicine or teams which include at least one full-time teaching staff of the faculty are qualified for contributions of the manuscripts to "Shimane Daigaku Igakubu Kiyo".

2. Content of Manuscripts

The manuscript, which has not been published previously and is not currently under consideration elsewhere, is permitted to submit. Manuscript can be written in either Japanese or European language. Original article, case report, review article, short communication (not exceed 2000 and 3000 words in European and Japanese language, respectively), and translation can be accepted. A brief case report is preferably submitted as a short communication.

Ethics of human study

The editors agree with the principles laid down in the Declaration of Helsinki (1964). Authors should ensure that their work complies with this declaration. Papers describing experimental work with humans should include this statement. Study or research of humans should be based on ethical guidelines and sufficiently protect human rights and privacy.

Ethics of animal experimentation

Animal experiments should be performed in accordance with the rules of this institution. Procedures should be such that animals do not suffer unnecessarily.

3. Preparation of Manuscripts

For details on the form of manuscripts refer to "Shimane Daigaku Igakubu Kiyo" (Current number). Original article, case report, and short communication must include a summary (not exceed 200 and 400 words of European and Japanese, respectively). Original article should be divided into (a) Summary, (b) Introduction, (c) Materials and Methods, (d) Results, Discussion, (f) Acknowledgments, and (g) References.

The title page should include the complete title of the article, three English key words, the full name (s) of the author (s), and the name of the institution where the work was done. All manuscripts must be typewritten with double-spaced on one side of the paper. Tables and illustrations should be prepared on separate A4 sheets. Only good drawings and original photographs can be accepted. Each photograph should have its number, the author's name and 'top' on the back.

Please submit the original plus two hard copies of the article including text, references, legends, tables, and figures.

4. The Editorial Board of the Shimane Journal of Medical Science and Bulletin of Shimane University Faculty of Medicine reserves the right to reject and edit the manuscript. When the manuscript is accepted for publication, the authors are required to submit a final version of the manuscript in Microsoft Word file to the editorial office via e-mail.

5. "Shimane Daigaku Igakubu Kiyo" is published annually.
