**Pharmacometrics** (Oyo Yakuri) publishes papers reporting original scientific and clinical research in the field of pharmacology. The journal publishes Original Articles, Rapid Communications, Reviews, Commentaries and Technical Notes.

### ETHICS

In scientific investigations involving human subjects, experiments should be performed in accordance with the ethical standards formulated in the Helsinki Declaration of 1964 (revised in 2000, cf. <http://ohsr.od.nih.gov/>). Similarly, animal experiments should follow the ethical standards formulated in the guidelines issued by the Science and International Affairs Bureau of the Japanese Ministry of Education, Science, Sports and Culture, No. 141, 1987: "Animal Experiments in Universities *etc.*"

### PAGE CHARGES

1. Page Charge: 5,500 Japanese yen per printed page (not including tax) for Original Papers, Reviews, Commentaries and Technical Notes. 13,000 Japanese yen per printed page for urgent printing including Rapid Communications.
2. Actual cost for photographs.
3. Actual cost for reprints. Numbers of reprints must be ordered , when you return the first proof.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTION

1. Manuscripts should be written in English or Japanese.
2. English manuscripts should be prepared with Times font.
3. The manuscripts must be typed with double spacing on one side of A4 size paper.
4. Each manuscript must be submitted in Duplicate. A floppy disk containing text and figure files must be sent with the revised manuscript.

The first page carries the title of the manuscript, names of authors, institutions and address.

Author(s), institution and address for correspondence including Tel and Fax numbers and E-mail at footnote. Followingly, an abstract not exceeding 250 words presented in a concise form and including the purpose, methods, results and conclusion of the research described in the paper. A list of keywords (less than 5) suitable for indexing. The first author and a running title should be prepared in a separated sheet.

**Abbreviations.** Abbreviation must be spelled out in full at their initial appearance, followed by the abbreviation in parentheses. Thereafter, the abbreviation may be employed. The abbreviation list must be appear in the end of the manuscript.

**Figures, Tables and Charts Showing Chemical Structure.** In principle, Fig., Table, Chart and Photo. should be written directly or printed in actual size in the desired location in the text.

**The References** should be cited in the text by the author's name and the year of publication. All references should be collected together at the end of the text as References. Abbreviations for Journals should confirm to Chemical Abstracts.

**Acknowledgements** should be appear just before the list of **References**.
